B/ Interesting points of the activity	Fifty seedsavers participated in this Annual Seed Exchange Festival. One hundred and fifty volunteers helped in the organisation and 3.000 visitors came to the Peliti land on that day to listen to the lectures and workshops and take traditional seeds which were distributed for free. Contact with the large public and answering their questions on local varieties of crop plants and especially on seed saving is an important challenge for spreading local varieties and thus maintaining the wealth of biodiversity and supporting natural evolution especially in a period of climate change
